THE 2022 PRIME MINISTER'S PRIZES FOR EXCELLENCE IN SCIENCE TEACHING

Know an inspiring science, mathematics or technology teacher?

Nominate them for national recognition!

The Prime Minister's Prizes for Science are Australia's most prestigious awards for outstanding achievements in scientific research, research-based innovation and excellence in science teaching.

Why nominate?

Nominating someone for a Prize is a meaningful acknowledgement of the value you think they contribute to science, mathematics or technology teaching.

There are two Science Teaching Prizes available for eligible Australian citizens/permanent residents:

- Prime Minister's Prize for Excellence in Science Teaching in Primary Schools
- Prime Minister's Prize for Excellence in Science Teaching in Secondary Schools.

Recipients receive \$50,000 each for their achievement.

The nomination process is simple.

1. **Nominate**—provide a 750-word summary of your nominee's achievements, contact details for two supporters and two independent referees.
2. **Shortlist**—if your nominee is shortlisted, you'll be asked to submit an online application form addressing an assessment criteria.
3. **Verify**—the independent selection committee will verify your submission.
4. **Notify**—recipients will be notified and invited to attend the event in October 2022!

The Department of Industry, Science, Energy and Resources is committed to improving the diversity of nominees for the Prizes. We particularly welcome nominations of women, Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander people, members of the LGBTIQA+ community, and people from regional and remote parts of Australia.
